Thailand is a fertile country where there are plenty of agricultural products to choose from in every season throughout the whole year. Thai Agricultural products are of great variety rich with high nutritional value including medicinal properties to prevent diseases and improve wellbeing

Good health originates from eating good quality and safety food. Organic products of Thailand have been certified in accordance with quality and safety requirements which are carefully controlled and inspected throughout the whole production process from farm to table, starting from production process, cultivation, harvest, product handling and food processing under organic standards. Thailand is renowned for its agricultural products on their qualities of production, taste and health benefits.

Thailand has the capability in producing organic products from, crop, aquaculture and livestock, with high potential in expansion of both domestic and international markets. The commodities can be divided into four groups, which are

- organic crops, e.g. Hom Mali rice, baby corn, asparagus, okra or lady's finger, ginger, herb, spice, tea, Pisang Mas banana, cavendish banana, longan, and pineapple, among others
- organic aquaculture, e.g. black tiger prawn and snakeskin gourami
- organic livestock e.g. swine, laying hen, and dairy cow
- others, e.g. honey



Organic Thailand



The Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, throt, has established, so far, seven Thai Agricultural Standards and one guideline related to organic production system which principally aligns with the international standard. These documents include general provision for production, processing, labeling and marketing of produce and products from organic agriculture, as well as the specific provisions for organic rice, organic livestock, organic marine shrimp farming, organic aquatic animal feed, organic snakeskin gourami and organic honey bee.
